TIPS FOR USING THE LIBRARY

The American Heritage Library, in Glendale, California, has been provided as a public service to the public since 1893, its purpose being to act as a repository for books and reference materials relating to the American Revolution; early American, California and local history; military history and genealogy.

Prior to the advent of the personal computer, a traditional card catalog was developed and maintained to assist patrons in accessing the Library's collection. In October, 2004 the Library completed a \$250,000 catalog modernization and collection reorganization project which included creation of an electronic catalog of its holdings which is accessible in the Library or on-line at: <u>http://www.srcalifornia.com/library/index.htm</u>. A brochure outlining use of the catalog is available. The electronic catalog is accessible in the Library on the patron computers.

The Library's electronic catalog is also accessible at libraries through OCLC, a worldwide library cooperative that maintains WorldCat. The electronic catalog includes all of the Library's holdings, including its book, manuscript and photo collections, and digital book collection. The entry for "Label Information" indicates where to find the title in our collection. Check the catalog to find references for your topic. For journals and periodicals, and multi-volume works, the record will provide detail in the listing of what our Library has under "Holdings".

The old card catalog is no longer maintained and is not current. It remains useful with thousands of annotations specific to family names contained in volumes acquired prior to 1986.

Internet Access

Internet access is available through the patron desktop computers or via wireless connection on your own hardware. Use your computer, tablet or smart phone wireless hardware to locate the network and enter the password.

Collection Organization

As you look at the main floor, the Library includes seven rows, or stacks, to the right of tables and chairs, plus additional shelves around the east and south perimeter walls. The window wall is to the north. A library map is available summarizing how the collection is organized.

The Stacks are assigned a letter from A-W. In the tips below, where a number appears after the letter, the number 1 refers to the left side of the stack as viewed from the end facing the room. Stacks A-G have two sides, each with seven sections. An example of how to read a location reference:

D-1-5 Refers to Stack D, side 1 (left side), fifth section.

Family genealogies are arranged in the stacks alphabetically by last name. Portions of the collection specific to a state are arranged as follows: states are grouped by region. Within a state, from broad topics to specific topics, e.g., histories or vital records statewide in scope, followed by county-specific collections and then city collections.

DIGITAL COLLECTION

The patron computer located to the left of the display case facing the main floor has on it hundreds of digital books and references which can be viewed on the computer. These are organized into folders which appear on the desktop. Double-right click a folder to see its contents. These references include:

Harleian Society Publications

The Harleian Society was founded in 1869 for the purpose of publishing manuscripts of the heraldic visitations (censuses) of the counties of England and Wales, and other unpublished manuscripts relating to genealogy, armory, and heraldry in its widest sense. Since its inception, the Harleian Society has published more than ninety volumes of parish registers, fifty four volumes of heraldic visitations, and seventy volumes drawn from other sources.

More than 100 titles are located in this folder. These early 17th century census records are arranged by county and an invaluable tool for genealogical research of this era.

THE PRINTED COLLECTION

The Library's printed collection of books, periodicals and circulars includes runs of many significant genealogical journals. While some are indexed in each volume, many have separate indexes. These indexes are located either with the journals in the collection or on the Index Table. Among those on the Index Table are:

Index Table

The Index Table is located in front of the large painting of John C. Fremont, at the east end of the library floor. The following is a summary of the indexes located at the Index Table.

Researchers are urged to search all variant spellings of surnames when looking up individuals.

Virginia Historical Index. Swem, Earl Gregg. Known as "Swem's", this is one of the most important research guides for Virginia historical and genealogical researchers compiled under the direction of Dr. Earl Gregg Swem (1870-1965). It is a comprehensive index to several publications concerning Virginia history and genealogy, including the following publications in our collection:
